### Rules for **ALL** Parade Participants

1. **Copy of \$20 million current Public Liability** must be attached (A business can ask to attach it to business public liability as a marketing operation. A registered vehicle usually has this in third party insurance).
2. It is illegal to allow anyone to ride on the back of the float whilst travelling outside the parade 'closed off' areas this includes to and from the assembly point. It is a \$2,000 fine for everyone on the float. Floats to convene in Pudman Street in numerical order as directed by **11.15AM** on **SUNDAY 30 SEPTEMBER 2018**. Floats should approach Pudman Street via **Scott Street**. However, the parade does not start until 12noon.
3. **Nothing to be thrown or passed from floats**. This includes water pistols, water bombs, lollies, fruit or anything else whatsoever.
4. No climbing or alighting from moving floats.
5. Go up the Main Street once and turn **right** into Jugiong Street. No float is to return down the main Street.
